RED & YELLOW DAY 2022 – NSW students were encouraged to wear red & yellow on December 1st to help us raise awareness of the red & yellow flags.

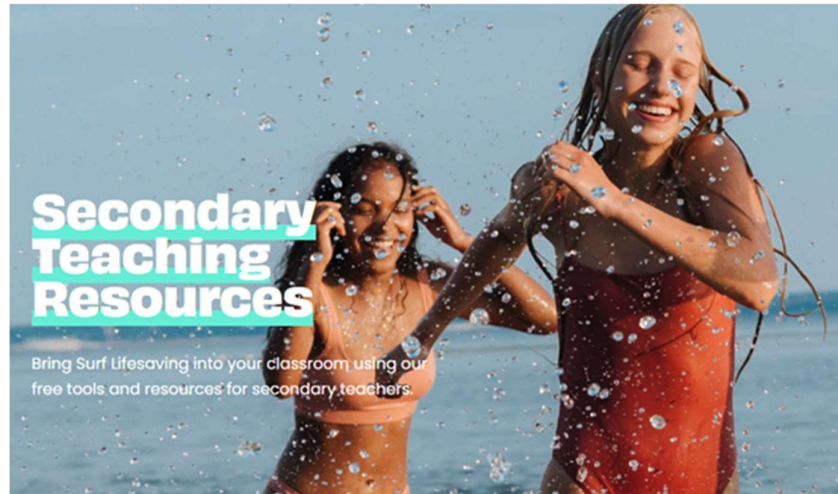


TEACHERS WEEK 2022 - A week of learning, collaboration and expert insights for primary and secondary teachers.



What's coming up in 2023?

SECONDARY TEACHING RESOURCES - Our team of educators and teachers have created curriculum aligned unit resources for Stage 4 to Stage 6 to assist teachers integrate beach and coastal safety activities into your lesson plans in an easy and simple way. These units are complemented by our secondary virtual and incursion programs. Each unit is stage based with a 3-4 week curriculum lesson plan and is supported by activity sheets and resources.



BEACH LIFE CHALLENGE GAME – Primary teachers and students will be able to use this fun and interactive resource to learn about Australian coastal and inland water safety. Students will have access to multiple questions under key categories and topics:

- **The Beach** (17 topics) i.e.: *Rock Pools, Lifeguards & Lifesavers, Did you Know? i.e. Freaky Facts, Myths & Legends*
- **Inland Waterways** (13 topics) i.e.: *Name that Animal!, Great Australian Waterways, Around the World*
- **Exploring My Environment** (Kindy) i.e.: *How can my senses help me to stay safe?, What can I learn about my environment from observation?*
- **Keeping My Community Safe** (Years 1-4) i.e.: *How do we care for and include each other?, What choices can help me to stay safe?*
- **Making Safe Choices** (Years 5-6) i.e.: *What skills and strategies can be used to manage challenging situations and seek help?, What positive actions contribute to my own safety and the safety of those around me?*
