### **Task Details**

You are to create a fully resourced Safety Plan for visiting a New South Wales beach of your choice with a trusted friend. Your plan must detail the following:

- Preparation Gaining knowledge of the beach, preparing equipment and personal safety, the present and forecasted conditions
- Gaining situational awareness on arrival details of the discussion you will be having with your friend on the Think Line (good place to observe conditions)
- Where to enter the surf, communicating in the surf and how to raise attention for assistance
- Emergency Plan for exiting the surf in an unsafe situation

You will need to provide a map detailing the location of hazards. You may use an aerial photograph or topographic map. You should consult Beachsafe website, knowledge you have gained in this unit and other appropriate resources.

Your Safety Plan is limited to 2 pages. It must include a reference list.
