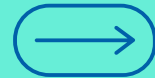

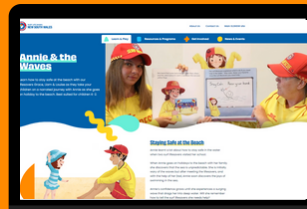


ANNIE & THE WAVES

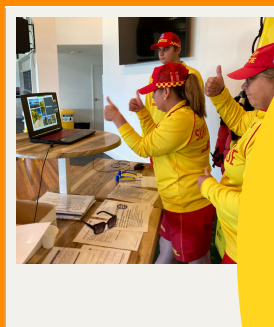

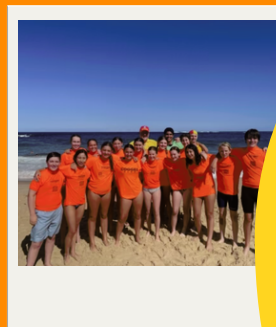

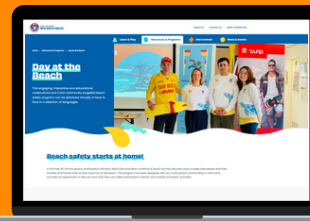

DAY @ THE BEACH

In this 45-60 minute session participants will learn about the Australian coastline and beach as they discover ways to keep themselves and their families and friends safe as they have fun at the beach. This program has been designed with multicultural communities in mind and provides an opportunity to discuss ways that they can safely participate in beach and coastal recreation activities.

GONE FISHING

In this 45-60 minute session participants will learn about the Australian coastline and water safety with a specific focus on rock platforms and high-risk fishing spots. This program has been designed with multicultural communities in mind and covers key safety messages including lifejackets, clothing, footwear, conditions and emergency scenarios.

BEACH LIFE PROGRAM

These 45-60 minute facilitated sessions are based on discussion and scenario based learning through key beach and coastal themes relevant to international students. Students will tackle topics related to drowning, risk taking behaviours and dangerous activities head on and we give students the opportunity to share their own experiences and stories.

CLASSROOM SESSION

BEACH OCEAN SAFE (BOS) PROGRAM

Theory and practical learning sessions at a Surf Life Saving Club with Surf Lifesavers focusing on beach safety, including topics such as reading signs at the beach, floating in rips, waves, and tides, swimming in beach conditions, basic CPR and first aid, emergency procedures, safe rock fishing, planning a safe trip to the beach, risks at the beach, and beach scenarios.

BEACH SAFETY ADVISER (BSA) PROGRAM

In this new initiative, individuals are trained to engage and educate members of the public on the beach. BSA's provide a last line of defense to educating children, families and the general public on beach safety and hazard awareness, both on the sand and before they enter the water. BSA's are members of the local club with a strong knowledge of the local area and hazards. BSA's provide a friendly, caring and knowledgeable welcome to the beach, ensuring beach goers are informed and aware of how to stay safe, where to ask a question and get help and where they can learn more.

BEACH SAFE SESSIONS

In this new initiative, individuals are trained to engage and educate members of the general public through short beach safety sessions run at a designated location and time at the club or on the beach. These sessions contain core beach safety information along with hazard awareness information specific to the location and conditions at the time. These sessions can be run as a static talk or a moving tour and provide an ideal way for beach goers to engage with surf lifesaving members and provides surf clubs with opportunities to not only educate on staying safe but engage beach goers in club activities and membership.

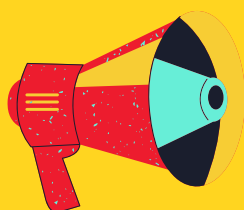

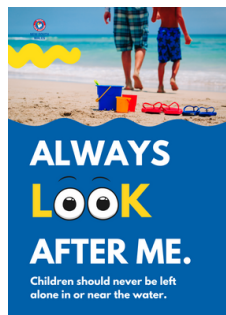

Beach safety starts at home

1 Select a safe beach...

- Download the Beachsafe app
- Is the beach patrolled by lifeguards today?
- Is the beach open or closed?
- What hazards are at the beach?
- How strong is the surf?

2 Pack items to keep you safe at the beach

- Sunscreen, hat and a long sleeve top
- Swimsuit
- Rock fishing safety gear
- Do not pack alcohol!

How to stay safe while at the beach...

- Always swim between the red & yellow flags
- Look for beach safety signs
- Say hello to a lifeguard
- Never swim alone
- If you get into trouble in the water, stay calm and raise your arm
- In an emergency - call 000
- Lifeguards are not babysitters
- How beach safe are you?

Rock Fishing Safety Starts at Home

1 Select a safe fishing spot...

- Check the conditions before you leave home
- What are the tides like?
- How deep is the water?
- How strong is the wind?
- Is this a sheltered spot?

2 Pack items to keep you safe at the beach

- Lifeguard
- Non-slip shoes & light clothing
- Rope or flotation device
- Do not pack alcohol!

How to stay safe while rock fishing...

- Look for hazard signage
- Observe the spot before you start
- Never go fishing alone
- Pick a safe spot and plan an escape route
- If you've washed into the ocean, stay calm and look for an exit
- If you see someone who is washed in the ocean, DO NOT jump in
- Learn to swim, learn to float, learn to survive
- How safe are you while rock fishing?

GOING ROCK FISHING?

WHAT YOU NEED TO STAY SAFE.

Check fishing in your local Authority's local designated spots, responsible for an average of eight deaths a year in NSW. "So how can you plan a safe rock fishing trip?"

Corflutes are a great visual aid that allow you to run a community education session anywhere without the need for technology.

COMMUNITY EDUCATION STARTER GRANT.

Looking to get started in the community education space and need some funds for the basic running of events and programs? Then these mini grants be just for you.

Key criteria for application for this grant:

- Activities must be for the sole purpose of community (non-member) education that is aimed towards at-risk members of our community.
- Activities must be completed by the end of April 2024.
- The club or branch applying for the grant must not have any pre-existing community education activities actively running.

There is no grant limit, but we do anticipate that funding requested will be for basic needs and requirements to support your club or branch to begin the delivery of selected community education activities and programs.

Grant funding might be requested to cover items such as:

- Purchase of branded rash vests and swim caps
- Purchase of projectors and TV screens for community education presentations.
- Purchase of educational indoor and outdoor banners
- Purchase of USB's, laptops and cables.
- Purchase of needed community education activity supplies and resources.
- Costs associated with hosting a community education information evening or workshop for members.

COMMUNITY EDUCATION INNOVATION GRANT.

Do you have an innovative, exciting and unique idea for a community education program or project but need some funding support to bring your idea to life? The innovation grant might be for you.

Key criteria for application for this grant:

- Activities must be for the sole purpose of community (non-member) education that is aimed towards at-risk members of your community.
- Activities must be undertaken or completed by the end of the 23/24 season.

There is no grant limit for this application but please be aware that funding acquittal will require the provision of invoices and receipts.

Expressions of interest will be judged based on criteria inclusive of:

- Potential impact to at-risk communities
- Cost versus benefit

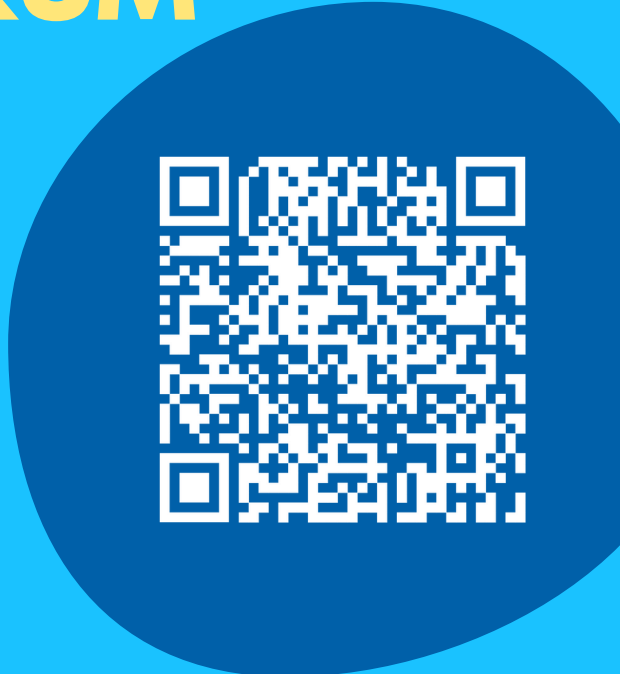

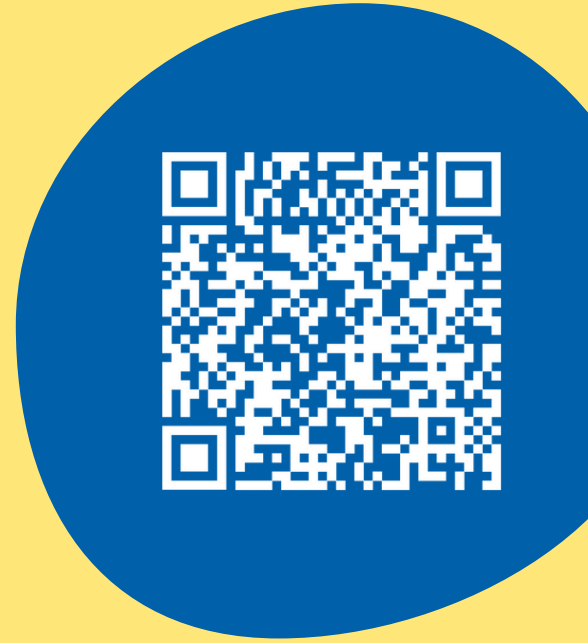

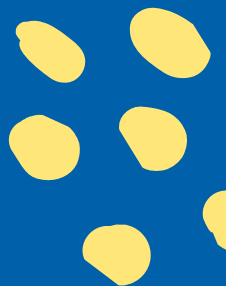
